Japan is composed of over 6,850 islands, yet most first-time travelers usually only visit Honshu - where Tokyo, Osaka & Kyoto are located.

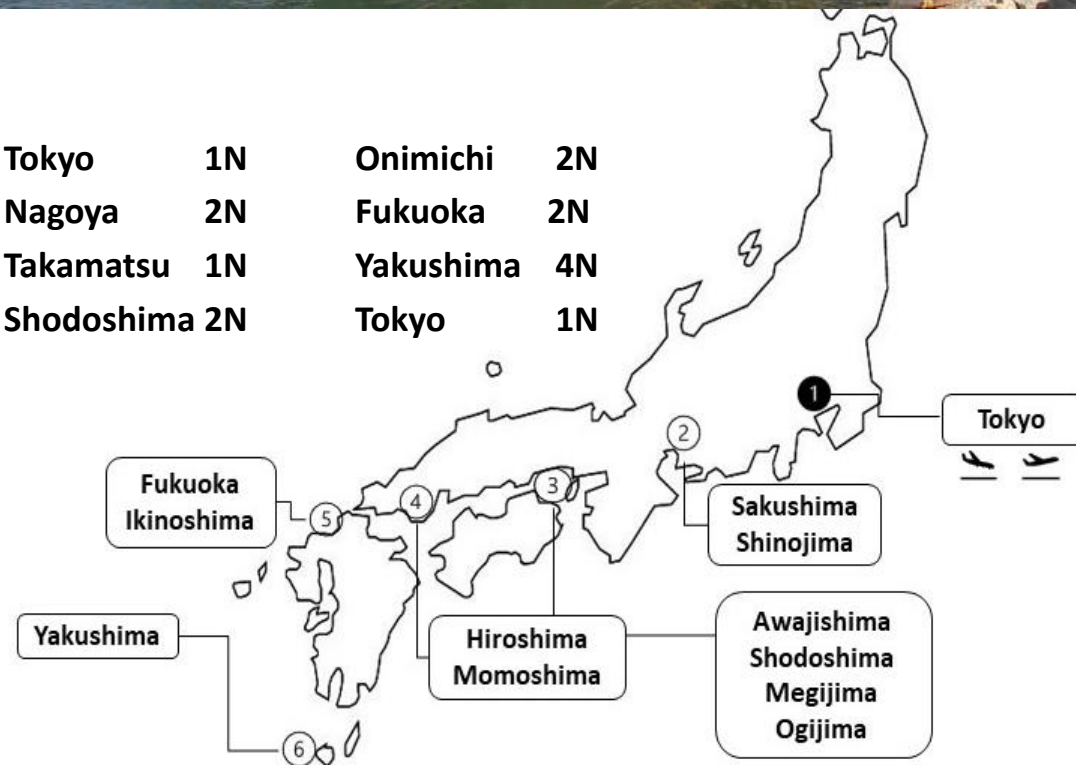
